How Do I Connect?

- ISP: Internet Service Provider (Examples: Spectrum, AT&T, Comcast)
- ISP ➤ Modem/Router ➤ Wi-Fi ➤ Device
- Fiber, cable, and wireless connections: available in cities and suburbs
- Satellite, DSL, mobile broadband (with hotspots): options for rural areas
- Compare plan details and choose one that best suits your needs.

Finding Low-Cost Internet Plans

- Visit <u>EveryoneOn.org</u> to search for reduced cost plans and check eligibility requirements.
- Examples of low-cost plans include: <u>Access from AT&T</u>, <u>Cox ConnectAssist</u>, <u>Optimum Advantage</u>
 Internet, Xfinity Internet Essentials
- Monthly costs range from \$10 to \$30.
- The FCC's <u>Lifeline</u> program provides a discount for phone or internet service (based on income).
